

The Life Tables for Northern Ireland for 1950-1952 prepared by the Government Actuary in London, are obtainable from H.M. Stationery Office (price 2s. 6d.) and those for earlier census periods are included in section III of the Ulster Year Book, 1956, also obtainable from H.M. Stationery Office (price 5s.). The expectation of life at birth in the case of boys was 47-1 years in 1901, 55-3 in 1926, 65-5 in 1951 and 67-4 in 1956. The respective figures for girls are—46-7, 56-1, 68-8 and 71-0.

MIGRATION

The population figures ascertained at each census enable the net migration during the inter-censal periods to be calculated. The last two censuses in Northern Ireland were taken on 28th February, 1937, and 8th April, 1951. The following statement reveals that, during the intervening period of a little over 14 years, there was a net outward movement of 67,267 persons. Gross figures for migration inwards and outwards are not available. The table relates to migration to and from all countries, including other parts of the British Isles.
